

Steps to Becoming a

Certified S.C. Clean Marina



1 Take the Pledge

The pledge is a commitment that your marina will become certified and meet the required practices within the next year.



2 Conduct a Self-Assessment

Use the checklist to conduct an assessment of your marina. You must meet all requirements specified.



3 Sign up for a Workshop

The workshop will walk you through the steps to certification and how to get your marina ready for inspection. Registration is \$100 that can be applied toward the total \$250 certification cost.



4 Schedule an Inspection

Contact us when you believe your marina meets all the checklist requirements and our inspectors will come for a site visit. Upon review, you will receive feedback and notice of status.



5 Receive your Designation

Congratulations! Your status will be promoted on our websites.



6 Maintain Status

You must attend a recertification workshop every 5 years, or if your marina changes ownership or management to keep your status.
